SUBJECT: THREAT ADVISORY - COLUMBUS DAY IN LATIN AMERICA

TEXT:

1. THIS IS A COORDINATED COMMUNITY THREAT ADVISORY FROM STATE, CIA, NSA, AND DIA IN COORDINATION WITH THE SERVICES. THE EXECUTIVE COORDINATOR, COMMUNITY COUNTERTERRORISM BOARD, CONCURS WITH THIS ADVISORY. THIS ADVISORY WILL EXPIRE IN TWO WEEKS.

2. THE U.S. INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY ASSESSES THAT THERE IS AN INCREASED POTENTIAL FOR TERRORIST VIOLENCE IN SELECTED LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE OCTOBER 12 OBSERVANCE OF THE 500TH ANNIVERSARY OF COLUMBUS' ARRIVAL IN THE NEW WORLD. SEVERAL GROUPS REPORTEDLY EQUATE THE DATE WITH THE ONSET OF SPANISH IMPERIALISM, AND THE DESTRUCTION OF INDIGENOUS CULTURE. THE GROUPS GENERALLY VIEW THE U.S. AS THE HEIR TO SPAIN'S ROLE IN LATIN AMERICA. THEIR PLANNED ACTIVITIES INCLUDE MARCHES, ROADBLOCKS, SITINS, AND HOSTILE DEMONSTRATIONS AT GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND FOREIGN EMBASSIES. DEMONSTRATIONS, SOME OF WHICH COULD TURN VIOLENT, MAY ALSO BE DIRECTED AGAINST U.S. INTERESTS AND SYMBOLS.

- 3. THERE ARE REPORTS THAT SOME GROUPS ARE PLANNING TERRORIST ACTIVITY CONNECTED WITH COLUMBUS DAY COMMEMORATIONS. MANY OF THESE GROUPS HAVE NOT RECENTLY STAGED MAJOR TERRORIST INCIDENTS, AND THEIR PLANS PROBABLY EXCEED THEIR CAPABILITIES. INCREASED SECURITY PRECAUTIONS WILL ALSO FRUSTRATE SOME OPERATIONS. NEVERTHELESS, THERE IS EVIDENCE OF POSSIBLE TERRORIST ACTIVITY IN THE FOLLOWING COUNTRIES:
- DOMINICAN REPUBLIC: SOME DOMINICAN LEFTIST ORGANIZATIONS REPORTEDLY ARE PLANNING A BOMBING CAMPAIGN BEGINNING OCTOBER 5 AND LASTING THROUGH OCTOBER 12. BOMBS ARE TO BE TARGETTED AGAINST HISTORICAL AND SYMBOLIC SITES TO GAIN MEDIA ATTENTION, AND NOT TO CAUSE PHYSICAL INJURIES. THIS CAMPAIGN CORRESPONDS WITH THE COLUMBUS DAY OBSERVANCES AND THE VISIT OF POPE JOHN PAUL II FROM OCTOBER 10-13. BECAUSE OF THE PRESENCE OF FOREIGN GUESTS, WE EXPECT MAJOR HOTELS IN SANTO DOMINGO TO BE TARGETTED. OTHERWISE, WE HAVE NO REPORTS OF DIRECT THREATS TO U.S. INTERESTS.
- BOLIVIA: VARIOUS SOURCES INDICATE THAT SOME BOLIVIAN TERRORIST GROUPS MAY ATTEMPT ACTIONS AGAINST THE BOLIVIAN GOVERNMENT

AND U.S. INTERESTS BETWEEN OCTOBER 8 (THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF CHE GUEVARA) AND OCTOBER 20. WE BELIEVE INSTALLATIONS THAT LACK POLICE PROTECTION COULD BE MOST AT RISK. TARGETS WILL LIKELY BE COLOMBIAN GOVERNMENT INSTITUTIONS AND MULTI-NATIONAL

PERU: THE ARRESTS EARLIER THIS YEAR OF TOP LEADERS OF THE TUPAC AMARU REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT (MRTA) HAVE REDUCED ITS TERRORIST POTENTIAL, BUT IN SEPTEMBER THE MRTA HIGH COMMAND REPORTEDLY ISSUED AN ORDER TO BEGIN AN "AGGRESSIVE OFFENSIVE" AGAINST UNSPECIFIED U.S. AND SPANISH INTERESTS BEGINNING IN OCTOBER. ELEMENTS OF MRTA PLAN TO ENTER LIMA TO ATTACK U.S. INTERESTS TO PROTEST THE 500TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DISCOVERY OF THE AMERICAS. PRIOR TO THE CAPTURE

OF SENDERO LUMINOSO (SL) LEADER ABIMAEL GUZMAN ON SEPTEMBER 12, THE SL HAD REPORTEDLY PLANNED AN OFFENSIVE IN OCTOBER. THIS OFFENSIVE WAS NOT LINKED SPECIFICALLY TO COLUMBUS DAY. HOWEVER, THE GROUP MAY ATTEMPT ATTACKS ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 8, PERUVIAN NAVY DAY, OR OCTOBER 12, THE ONE-MONTH ANNIVERSARY OF GUZMAN'S CAPTURE; SUCH ATTACKS COULD BE TIED TO COLUMBUS DAY FOR PROPAGANDA PURPOSES. THERE ARE NO REPORTS OF DIRECT SL THREATS TO U.S. INTERESTS BUT THE GROUP MAY BELIEVE THAT HITTING A U.S. TARGET WILL GARNER INCREASED PUBLICITY AS SL SEEKS TO PROVE ITS ABILITY TO REBOUND FROM THE LOSS OF GUZMAN.

VARIOUS GROUPS IN GUATEMALA AND ECUADOR, TWO COUNTRIES WITH LARGE INDIAN POPULATIONS, ARE PLANNING PROTEST OBSERVANCES OF COLUMBUS DAY. THERE ARE NO REPORTS THAT U.S. INTERESTS HAVE BEEN TARGETED, BUT THERE IS A POSSIBILITY OF SPONTANEOUS RANDOM VIOLENCE.
